

Regulations of the Photo Contest “Holiday 2007”

Initial conditions

1. Present Photo Contest “Holiday 2007” is not a lottery game in the meaning of the act dated 29 of July 1992 about lottery games and bets.
2. The Organizer of the contest is company STRIMA Sp. z o.o. seated in Swadzim, ul. Poznanska 54, 62-080 Tarnowo Podgorne, Poland.
3. Contest lasts up to 23.09.2007.
4. The contest is conducted on the area of Poland, through the agency of BURDA magazine, internet web site www.strima.com and information-promotion brochure sent by post on 16.04.2007.

Principles of the participation in the contest

1. The contest has opened character; each of age person can be participant of the contest, including Strima Sp. z o.o. employees however, excluding members of the Contest’s Commission.
2. To take part in the contest it is necessary to send on Organizer’s address the best photo from holiday 2007. The photo should be send together with its description and filled-in contest coupon, which can be found in the BURDA magazine (May 2007 edition) as well as on the www.strima.com web site. Photo must be taken in 2007, required size of the photo 15x21cm. Description should include name of the photo’s author as well as date and place where the photo was taken. Every competitor may send maximum 3 photos. The contest lasts up to 23.09.2007; 24:00 - date of the postmark decides. Works can be delivered personally, after phone agreement on +48 61 8950 950.
3. Every Competitor agrees for storage and processing of his personal data by Strima Sp. z o.o. (Organizer) in order to make promotional and marketing actions, with accordance to text of the act about protection of personal data. Moreover, photos reported for the contest become property of the Organizer. Organizer reserves the right for their free reproduction in advertising materials as well as in other publications connected with the contest.

Awards

1. The Organizer sponsors awards in the contest.
2. Thirteen Competitors, who receive the highest amount of points, granted by the Contest Commission, will be awarded.
3. Awards in the contest are:
 - JANOME JEM PLATINUM 760 – multifunctional sewing machine
 - BATTISTELLA VAPORBABY INOX + BATTISTELLA TECNOSTIR MAXI CHROM – ironing set: ironing tale with steam generator and iron
 - PFAFF 1163-6/01 BS. kpl. - industrial lockstitch machine with clutch motor
 - consolation award (for 10 persons) - SPIRIT 77 MAX - spray 400 ml - stain remover + Mundial scissors set.
4. In case of sending more than one photo, each Competitor increases his chance for winning, but he is entitled to one award only.
5. The contest’s winners have the right to individual choice of awards, according to taken places.

Settlement of the contest

1. The contest will be settled on 10th of October 2007.
2. Works with the legibly filled-in coupon and fulfilling requirements described in point called "Principles of the participation in the contest" will be allowed to the contest.
3. Members of the Contest's Commission will settle the contest, keeping appropriate care. Members of the Contest's Commission are:

4. Contest's Commission will also watch over the proper course of the contest. Particularly the commission will verify information sent by Competitors, consider suggestions, complaints and carry on correspondence with Competitors.
5. Competitors will be rewarded on the basis of points granted by the Contest's Commission. Competitor, who reaches the biggest amount of points, has the right to choose his award as first. The person, who takes the second place, has the right to choose his award as second. The person who takes third place will be rewarded with third award. Ten following places will be rewarded with consolation awards. Settling the contest, Contest's Commission will take under consideration originality of sent photos. Organizer reserves the right, on behalf of Contest's Commission, to not give any award. The Contest's Commission decision must be justified in written.
6. The Contest's Commission will draw up and keep, to the end of the year 2007, data of winners ("Winners of the Photo Contest "Holiday 2007") and information about their awards as well as list of contest's participants together with an amount of reached points.
7. Results of the contest will be announced up to 16th of October 2007 on the Organizer web site www.strima.com.

Awards' presentation

1. Winners of the contest will be informed about the won awards immediately after the contest's settlement. Information will be sent on address given in the application.
2. Awards will be sent to Winners by registered mail within 21 days from the date of the contest's settlement, on the cost of Organizer.
3. Awards are not subject to be exchanged into money equivalent or another award.
4. In case Winner declines award's acceptance, Organizer is not obliged to award another Competitor.

Complaints

1. Every Competitor can inform the Contest's Commission about any irregularity connected with the contest. The Contest's Commission is at the same time the Complaint's Commission.
2. Competitor has the right to report complaints and notes connected with realization of the contest by means of e-mail or regular mail. The complaint should include, in particular, Competitor's demand and description of the way of the present regulations' infringement.
3. Complaints will be considered by the Complaint's Commission within 7 days from the date of its receiving. Competitor will be informed about the Complaint's Commission decision by means of the registered letter.
4. Decisions of the Complaint's Commission are binding and final, without the right of appeal.

Principles of taxation

1. Income gotten from title of award won in Photo Contest "Holiday 2007" is subject of taxation on principles defined in act about income tax from physical persons.

Final rulings

1. In case of change of Competitor's data, he or she is obliged to inform about it the Organizer without a delay.
2. Organizer has the right to disqualify a Competitor from participation in the contest, in case he or she infringes contest's regulations.
3. Organizer reserves the right to introduce changes in the present regulations at any time, without announcing reasons, by placing an appropriate information in the web site www.strima.com.
4. Changes made in the regulations may not infringe rights acquired by Competitors.
5. Present regulations are available on the web site www.strima.com and in the Organizer's head quarter.
6. Organizer does not bear responsibility for correctness and punctuality of delivery by post or courier mails sent on behalf of Organizer in the connection of conduct of the contest.
7. Organizer does not bear responsibility for application by Competitor unsuitable or false data concerning address of residing or other data, making impossible or delaying presentation of awards, connected with conduct of the contest.
8. In case presentation of an award becomes impossible because of the above-mentioned reasons, Winner may report personally to the Organizer's had quarter to collect the award. He or she should report within 30 days from the date of the contest's settlement, presenting appropriate documents, being a basis to establish the right to the award's collection.
9. In case an award is not collected in the closing date mentioned in the above point, Competitor loses the right to the award and Organizer is not obliged to award another person.
10. All disputes, which may result in the connection with conduct of the contest, are to be submitted to arbitration at the court proper for the Organizer's seat.
11. Taking part in the contest Competitor confirms that he or she agrees to obey the rules of the contest, specified in the regulations.
12. The personal data administrator is Organizer.
13. The present regulations are the only document having a binding legal force in the field of conduct of the contest.
14. Proper regulations of the Civil Code will be applied regarding all cases unsettled in the present regulations.
